

Items to Bring Women's Programs

- Completed Medical Exam form (including lab tests)
_____ T.B. Skin Test _____ Chest X-ray (if TB Positive)
_____ HIV antibody test _____ Blood test results for Hepatitis A, B & C
- \$1,500 Application Fee
- At least one set of twin sheets, pillow, pillowcase, comforter, laundry bag, clothes hangers, shower shoes, 2 towels and washcloths
- Dress clothes for church (dress shoes must not have a heel greater than three inches)
- Full back under wear
- Loose fitting casual clothing (please no tight or form fitting clothing)
- Tennis shoes (all black or mostly black is preferred)
- Any shorts, skirts, or dresses must be knee length
- Undershirts to be tucked in under clothing (spaghetti strap or tank)
- One ring, bracelet, and necklace may be worn. Earrings may not be bigger than quarter size. No gauges.
- Personal hygiene items (soap, shampoo, toothpaste, deodorant, razors, etc.) (No alcohol based, aerosol products, or perfumes)
- Hair may be dyed but must be a naturally occurring color. (Please no pinks, purples, etc.)
- Black closed toe shoes, black pants, and a solid color shirt for choir outreaches
- A Christian themed t-shirt to be worn on work crews
- Bible or Study Bible, notebook, notebook paper, pens, pencils, stationery, stamps, etc.
- 200 – 3x5 index cards
- Driver's license or some form of picture ID and Social Security Card
- A personal vehicle may not be left on campus.
- Wal-Mart cards are permitted for incidentals and locked in office.
- Cell Phones are not permitted.
